DAN COKER, veteran missionary to Latin America, will speak this morning in our English-language worship. **DAN** is considered an outstanding university professor of Bible, missions, Latin American history, cultural anthropology, and linguistics. He and his wife **ELISE** have been resident missionaries in Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico & Uruguay. **DAN** holds BA and MA degrees in Biblical studies from ACU and a Ph.D. from the University of Florida. His doctoral dissertation addresses the dynamics involved in teaching the Gospel in multicultural societies. **DAN** and his wife, **ELISE**, currently worship at the North Davis congregation in Arlington. They are the parents of two daughters.

DAN has devoted his life to evangelizing Latin America. He served as Program Coordinator for the Ministry of Education in Tegucigalpa, Honduras; Professor of International Development Education at the University of Southern Florida; Director of the Baxter Institute of Biblical and Philosophical Studies in Mexico; and Professor of Bible and Cultural Anthropology at ACU. Since 2004, he has been Executive Director of Instituto Latinoamericano De Estudios Biblicos (ILEB International) located in Toluca, Mexico. **DAN** has been a campaign speaker in every Spanish-speaking country in the Western Hemisphere. He also is a staff writer for the Spanish version of CHRISTIAN CHRONICLE, *Cronica Cristiana*.

LIFELINE CHAPLAINCY (CONTINUED)

Our people . . . are the heart and soul of our ministry. From our professional staff of chaplains and instructors to our trained volunteers, it is the personal touch that makes the difference. Our board of directors, office staff and various individuals and churches provide administrative and financial support to our ministry. Our chaplains bring the expertise and training needed to provide quality care. Our trained volunteers extend that care to an ever growing number of patients and their families and/or caregivers. Interns, pursuing an education in crisis ministry, add even another element to the services we offer. All combined, we provide a network of caring people who offer a lifeline to those facing serious illness and loss.

We attempt to be available to all patients who desire visitation, and to provide any help we can in ways that will facilitate healing. A chaplain from the Church of Christ is available at the Texas Medical Center hospitals, the Dallas Metroplex and Scott and White Hospital in Temple and St. David's Medical Center-Austin.

Dealing with a serious illness . . . whether one's own or that of a loved one, is a load to bear in itself. Add to that the financial obligations, both medical and non-medical, that always accompany a critical illness. One quickly feels overwhelmed by the demands made upon one's resources.

Lifeline Chaplaincy's Compassionate Touch™ Program seeks to ease this burden by providing a non-medical one time funding to in-patients being seen at one of the area hospitals.

Lifeline Chaplaincy's Compassionate Touch™ Program since June 1997 has continued to help provide some comfort to patients and their families whether the need is short-term housing while undergoing treatment, parking assistance, or just a meal to help feed a family member. Patient or their family member may contact the hospital's social worker in their area concerning qualifications for our program.
