Webb Chapel's Benevolence Ministry assists members of our local community by meeting emergency needs for clothing and food. Within the first few weeks following the establishment of the congregation in January 1956, Webb Chapel was offering assistance to those in need locally. The Benevolence Ministry as it is today was begun on December 13, 1971. Since that time, funding for this ministry has been and still is provided solely by collections in Webb Chapel's Sunday morning Bible classes. Emergency clothing and canned goods are provided to those in need as funding allows.

Two special programs are sponsored by Benevolence: **Thanksgiving Baskets** and the **James Group Kids' Shopping Night**.

Thanksgiving Baskets

Each November, Webb Chapel members provide food and cooking items needed to prepare traditional Thanksgiving dinners. Baskets are prepared containing all that is needed to prepare a dinner for one family. These baskets are distributed to local families, the number determined by the amount of goods provided by the congregation.

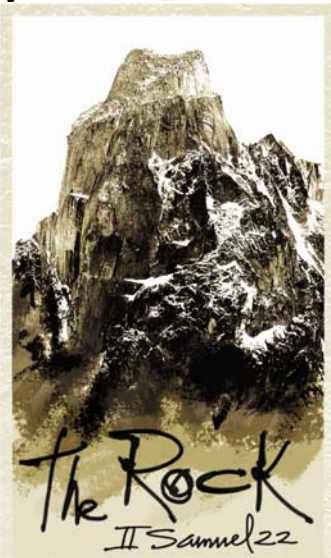
