I just attended the 90th birthday of my mother-in-law, and what a party it was! There were three large cakes, 200 cupcakes, candy galore, balloons everywhere, snacks on every table, and right in the middle of it all, there she was! She was a bit slower than she has been, she misses about half of everything said, and after a while, she seemed a bit tired. But in spite of all that, I realized again that one does not have to be perfect to have a marvelous influence on those around them or to be used effectively by God. Those she has influenced were there "en masse." We need to quit looking at our faults and weaknesses and begin looking at what God can do with a willing spirit.

Does the Bible not tell us that? 

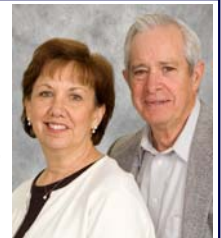
CARE GROUP LEADERS CHANGE

IN THE MIDST OF THE STORM. Monterrey was one of the most devastated cities after intense rains caused by Hurricane Alex last month. The authorities declared that several sectors of the city were emergency areas. In of those sectors is MONTE KRYSAL, where the Webb Chapel Church of Christ has been doing mission work for over seven years now. The rain and the floods, however, are just another problem added to the devastating violence which has afflicted several states of the Mexican Republic. MONTE KRYSAL, an already marginal neighborhood, has been at the center of both tragedies. In the midst of the storm, however, Jesus is placing his seed of peace and hope in the hearts of hundreds of people.

This past Thursday, MONTE KRYSAL initiated their yearly VBS, which will go through today. There were over 250 people with wide smiles and a spark of expectation in their eyes at the inauguration of this event. This year, none of the members of the Webb Chapel Church could be there, collaborating with the Mexican brothers, but our sister church in Monte Krystal began their VBS with great enthusiasm and determination. Sacrificing their scarce resources, they built THE GOOD NEWS TRAIN which picked up people from all over the neighborhood to bring them to the THE FAITH STATION. And they do need good news and faith!

Faith converts the impossible into a sea of opportunities. It moves mountains, and eliminates obstacles. Where there is no faith, death reigns. When faith comes, life springs even from the tomb. The VBS in Monte Krystal is the fruit of the faith of all the people who, trusting Jesus, did their part to see the finished work. Aside from the church members, we need to mention the soccer team, PATRIOTAS DE SIÓN, who built the railroads. We also need to mention MR. ROGELIO and his wife, who are not members of the church but helped with the enclosure of the rudimentary pavilion where the presentations are shown and MR. FELIPE, the owner of a small wood deposit, who donated all the wood, ready and cut, for the building of the railroads. If there is faith, there are resources. EN MEDIO DE LA TORMENTA. Monterrey es una de las ciudades más afectadas por las intensas lluvias que ocasionó el primer ciclón de la temporada de huracanes del 2010. Varias áreas de la gran Metrópoli fueron clasificadas zona de desastre, entre ellas Monte Krystal, un barrio marginado donde una pequeña comunidad cristiana vive cotidianamente la presencia de Jesús. Sin embargo, las recias lluvias son sólo un problema más que se suma a la intensa y devastadora violencia que por los últimos dos años ha golpeado varios estados de la república Mexicana, y Monte Krystal ha estado en el centro de las dos tragedias. Sin embargo, en medio de la estrepitosa tormenta Jesús silenciosamente sigue fermentando cientos de corazones con la levadura de la paz y la esperanza. Ayer se inició en la iglesia de Monte Krystal la Escuela Bíblica de Verano, que durará hasta el Domingo. Cerca de 250 personas asistieron a la inauguración con hermosas sonrisas y ojos iluminados de expectativas. Este año ninguno de los miembros de la Iglesia de Cristo en Webb Chapel en Dallas, que por seis años consecutivos se han hecho presentes, pudieron ir a colaborar con los hermanos mexicanos. Pero la iglesia hermana de Monte Krystal empezó con gran fuerza su «escuelita». Sacrificando sus propios recursos en aras de amor al Señor, en medio de pobrezas y carencias, diseñaron «El Trenecito De La Buena Nueva», que recorrió el barrio recogiendo niños y adultos para llevarlos a la «Estación de la Fe»; y vaya que Monte Krystal necesita en estos momentos fe y buenas noticias! La fe hace que lo imposible se vuelva realidad. Mueve montañas, destruye obstáculos y multiplica posibilidades. Donde falta la fe se impone la muerte, pero donde nace la fe hasta de la fosa surge la vida. La Escuela de Vacaciones en Monte Krystal es fruto de la fe de cada hombre y mujer, joven o viejo, que, creyendo en la palabra de Jesús, puso su granito de arena para ver luego la gran obra terminada. Aparte de los miembros de la iglesia, cabe aquí mencionar especialmente a los jóvenes del equipo de fútbol «Los Patriotas de Sion» que construyeron las carrileras del tren. Además, también hay que mencionar a don Rogelio y su esposa quienes, sin ser miembros de la iglesia, cubrieron con lonas la palapa donde habrían de hacerse las presentaciones; y, por supuesto, también a don Felipe, el dueño de un deposito de madera, quien donó toda la madera lista y cortada para la construcción de la carrilera. Si hay fe hay recursos y nada es imposible. ¡Felicidades a la iglesia en Monte Krystal!
