One of the active ministries we have at Webb Chapel is the James Group. While most of us have heard that name often and we know the work of Steve and Carole Steele, most of us are not familiar with its program and the effect it is having on the lives of so many. Steve and Carole have invested their lives into the lives of those who struggle with addictive behaviors (drug, alcohol, sexual, etc.), but they desire for this program to outlive them and continue far into the future. So, over the next few months, you will begin to see some rather progressive and challenging plans made for this ministry. In the meantime, we need to understand how active this ministry is. In just the last few weeks, they have seen 21 new folks who have been referred to them by local churches and previous clients. They currently have three ongoing Bible studies and have had two recent baptisms. Along with their Monday evening meeting, they have added a Friday evening meeting. And all this goes along with the Tuesday and Thursday nights when the James-Group-style Grupo Apoyo meet.

Brethren, these groups are meeting to deal with broken lives one at a time, and they are having great success changing those lives for the better. I hope that you will be in prayer for the success of the James Group Ministry. There will be some activities that each of us can participate in as well as different ways we can support this ministry. Be watching for some exciting things to be on the way.

Secondly, as I write this, I have 23 who have made plans to attend the EEM Dinner on September 9th, 2010, at the Hilton Dallas Lincoln Center at 5410 LBJ Freeway. The dinner is from 7:00 until 9:00 PM, but we need to arrive early to find our tables. Tanya, one of my translators in Ukraine, will be there. You will get to hear Zhenya, a coal miner who has started several churches and Dino Roussos, a native Greek evangelist who also works with a Russian church in Greece. You will hear about churches that have been planted in Ukraine; you will hear others who are involved in teaching there and placing Bibles in the school districts of that country. Call me at the office if you would like to go; I have two tables filled and would love to have three tables of WCCC folks.

HASTA UN NIÑO PUEDE. Hace unos cuantos días leí un artículo que me impresionó. Según Nick O'Neil en una Bitácora titulada «Todo de Facebook (All Facebook)» Logan Ludwin, un niño de trece años creó una página en la conocida red social que logró reunir 16,000 admiradores en 96 horas y que está creciendo a razón de 3,000 admiradores por día. ¿Cómo pudo una página alcanzar tanta gente en tan corto tiempo? Veamos de qué trata la página. Logan se dio cuenta de que Logan, un oficial de la policía condecorado, quien había servido a su comunidad por 19 años, estaba muriendo de cáncer. El oficial, quien había trabajado para la Oficina Metropolitana de autoridades de tránsito de Washington, estaba recibiendo una pensión de \$3,000 al mes, pero se la cortaron a \$700. Como resultado de esto, tuvo que declararse en bancarrota, perdió su casa, y tuvo que irse a vivir en el sótano de la casa de su hijo. Logan creó su página en Facebook para contar esta historia. La página se llama simplemente «Officer Ludwin». ¿Qué hizo que esta página llegara a ser tan popular?

En primer lugar, contiene una historia motivadora. Todos sentimos lo que le pasó al oficial Ludwin. Algo dentro de nosotros protesta contra la idea de que alguien que haya servido abnegadamente a su comunidad por 19 años termine en semejante adversidad. Este tipo de historia mueve a la gente. Pero, ¿habrá alguna historia más motivadora que la de Jesús? Francamente, jamás he oído historia semejante. ¿Entonces por qué la gente no se siente inspirada a escribir sobre ella, a escucharla, hablar de ella o compartirla? ¿Será que al hablar de la historia, nosotros mismos no hemos sido movidos por ella? La historia de su abuelo fue impactante para Logan. Su pasión es contagiosa inclusive por medio de los dígitos de la Internet. ¿Haremos perdido nosotros la pasión por la Historia de Cristo? ¿Nos habremos hechos apasionados de nuestra religión y no de la Historia? Habrá atenuado la rutina la intensidad de nuestra pasión por la cruz y la resurrección de Jesús? Leí el artículo y me sentí impulsado a dejarme llevar por la Historia de Cristo. Creyendo en ella, no puedo hacer menos que eso. Pero prosiguiendo con la historia de Logan, creo que su historia no fue el único secreto de su éxito.

La historia de su abuelo llevó a Logan a tomar acción. Tomó tiempo para crear su página en Facebook. Tal vez pidió consejo de otros. Recopiló fotos, videos, entrevistas y todo lo necesario para contar su historia. Actualmente la mantiene al día. Logan oyó la historia, la historia movió su corazón y el joven actuó. ¿No es esta una secuencia lógica? ¿Si creemos en la historia de Jesús, no debemos hacer algo al respecto? Y no estoy hablando de seguir su palabra en el bautismo. Después de bautizarnos no podemos sentarnos cómodos en la banca sin hacer nada por la Cruz. Lo triste en nuestros días es que muchos cristianos dicen que creen en la Historia de Cristo pero no hacen nada por ella. Por eso, la historia más poderosa jamás contada se queda dormida, en espera de un corazón apasionado que reviva. Pero por más que una persona se apasiona, falta aún la colaboración otros para difundir en mensaje.

¿Cómo pudo una página en Facebook alcanzar 16 mil personas en 98 horas? La respuesta es simple. Cada persona que se sintió tocada por la historia, la recomendó a otro. ¡Se extendió como fuego! Igual se expandió el evangelio en el primer siglo. ¿Por qué han tanta gente en nuestra época que no conoce la historia de la cruz? Tal vez porque no la compartimos. Piensa en esto. Muchas veces no tenemos que hacer mucho.No tenemos que ir a una tierra lejana a hacer obra misionera, no tenemos que dedicarle horas a preparar un sermón o una clase, tampoco tenemos que escribir un cheque gordo para apoyar una obra evangélica. A veces todo lo que tenemos que hacer es clic sobre un botón en nuestra pantalla. ¿Por qué será que no podemos a veces ni hacer un clic por el evangelio? ¡Que Dios nos de la pasión, no mueva a actuar y nos aliente a compartir la buena Nueva!
